Advising Appointment Checklist

To prepare for your advising appointment:

- If you are a student who is new to college, take the COMPASS placement test and attend a New Student Orientation. Sign up for an orientation at: <https://northseattle.edu/advising/new-student-orientation-signup>

- Test is required if you have not successfully completed college level math within the last two years and college level English Composition.

What to bring to your appointment:

- A copy of your test scores
- Unofficial or official transcripts (if you have attended another college)

Note: South Seattle CC and Seattle Central CC students do not need to bring test scores or transcripts.

What to do after your appointment:

- After your advising appointment and when you are registered for classes, if you wish to transfer credits to North, request an evaluation of your transcript(s) by submitting official transcripts with a Transcript Evaluation Request form.
