To Pay for the TEAS

The fee for the TEAS at North Seattle College is \$91 total (\$66 test plus \$25 proctoring fee)

You will need to create an account at www.atitesting.com and register and pay online for the exam.

What is the TEAS like?

North Seattle College gives
TEAS version 6.0.

The TEAS is a 170-question, multiple-choice computerized exam across four subject areas:

| English/Language Usage | 34 minutes/34 questions |

To Prepare for the TEAS

- ATI Testing sells both a TEAS study manual and an online practice test, which can be purchased from its online store.

- There are also many other study guides offered by other companies; most can be purchased from booksellers such as Amazon.com or Barnes & Noble. Test preparation publishers such as Kaplan, Barron's, and The Princeton Review are considered reputable and reliable sources for study materials.

On Test Day

- **Do not be late** for the test. Latecomers will not be admitted.
- **Bring photo ID.** No one will be admitted without photo ID.
- It will not be necessary to bring any supplies with you to the test. They will be provided.
- **Calculators are not permitted.**

- Results are displayed immediately, and you may print them.
- Results are posted immediately to your online account at www.atitesting.com, which we will help you create. You may print an **unofficial** copy here to include with your Seattle Central application.
- You will receive percentile scores for each of the four subjects, plus an overall composite score.
- Check with the program to determine TEAS score admission criteria.
- You will need a quarter for a locker on test day to put away your personal belongings.
- **The following items are not allowed in the testing center: no paper, no pencils, no pens (writing materials and scratch paper will be provided), no phones, no watches, no Fitbits, no hats or scarves (unless for religious reasons), no wallets, no keys, no purses, no backpacks, no laptops, no long necklaces, no pendants or bracelets that jingle, water is allowed as long as it is in a sealable container.**

Retesting

- There is no waiting period to retake the TEAS.
- There is no limit to the number of times you may take the TEAS.
- TEAS scores are valid for **18 months** at North Seattle College (This may be different at other colleges.)
