Patients usually require more than a simple filling. Dental services are performed by students under the direct supervision of experienced dentists who are faculty members of the School of Dentistry. Services range from fillings, root canals, crowns, implants, complete and partial dentures and more. Due to the instruction time during your appointment, patient visits are two to three hours long. The first appointment will consist of a comprehensive assessment of patient's teeth and mouth. A complete set of dental X-rays will be taken. Patients should allow three to four hours for this visit. No dental treatment is provided during this exam. Flat rate for each service. Cost is less than a private dentist. The full mouth exam is \$140. Crowns start at \$900 and dentures are between \$600 and \$800. Does not provide free care or offer sliding scale fees. Payment for services is due at each visit. <b>FOR MEDICAID ELIGIBLE PATIENTS:</b> The full mouth exam is \$58. Other procedures include one-surface fillings for \$32, root canals for \$235 and complete upper or lower dentures for \$390, excluding the cost of any needed extractions.</p>
